









Total Absentee and Mail-In Ballots Returned and Percent Remaining to be Counted (1 of 3)

Shown in the table below are absentee and mail-in ballot counts for the May 16th, 2023, Primary Election. The table shows the number of absentee and mail-in ballots recorded as returned in SURE (this number will change as ballots are received through the deadline and are entered by counties). County boards of elections are working on counting and reconciling the ballots, and in most cases will not finish counting mail-in and absentee ballots on election night. Ballots received through 8pm on Election Day will be entered and reported after the earlier ballots have been recorded. Ballots returned are being pre-canvassed and canvassed until a final determination is made. The count will be reflected on this report only after the county makes the adjustments in SURE. This may lead to fluctuations in the percentage remaining to be counted. Hence, this dashboard should be considered as an approximation. Counties are in the process of reconciling ballots recorded in SURE.

Percentage of Mail Ballots to be Counted by County Name











Percent Reporting by County






